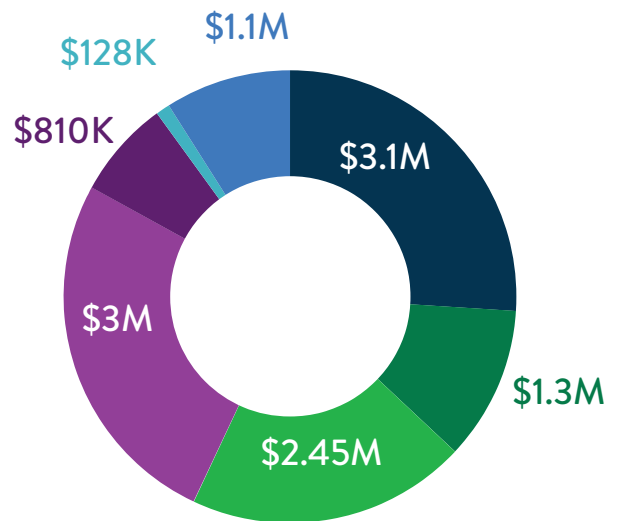


2024 Revenue Summary
